### **Can you help us this year?**

We would love to have you participate in our 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Day of Caring. Recruit family, friends, neighbors, and coworkers to make a team. Teams can range in size from two up to ten. The Annual Day of Caring is “**One Day to Help One Another**”. Teams provide services that people, for diverse reasons, cannot do. Some non-professional service projects include small painting projects, raking leaves, washing windows, cleaning gutters, or other yard work. This year we are limiting the projects to outside projects only and to teams of ten or fewer volunteers. **Most teams complete their projects by noon, so you do not have to give up an entire Saturday.**

We are including a team participation form to return to the United Way office by September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to let us know that you will or will not have a team participate in the Day of Caring. We ask for contact information to update our information for your team. Most importantly it asks for an *approximate team size*, this information is critical for assigning projects. We do not need volunteer names just a yes or no and a *guess* on your team size.

### **Team Leader Information**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will not be having a kick-off breakfast. Instead team leaders can pick up information and project assignments **October 19<sup>th</sup>, from 10:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.** at the Lind House. If you cannot pick up your project assignments and information sheets from United Way office, we will email them to you.

We encourage our teams to pick up their assignments early and to drive by the locations to assess the project to be better prepared the day of the event.

If you wish, you and your team may stop by the Lind House-622 Center Street from 7am to 8am to pick up facemasks (if needed), hand sanitizer, and disinfecting wipes to use while completing your assigned projects. The United Way will also have bottled water and treat available for your team members! All volunteers must sign our Day of Caring Volunteer waiver, with extra forms available at this time. \*Anyone under the age of 18, must have a parent/guardian signature on the form.

**CORONAVIRUS / COVID-19 WARNING.** Coronavirus, COVID-19 is a contagious virus that spreads easily through person-to-person contact. Federal and state authorities recommend social distancing and wearing a mask as ways to prevent the spread of the virus.
